#### The School

Cary Academy is an independent, coeducational, college preparatory day school for grades 6-12. The school is located on a 65-acre campus in the heart of the dynamic Research Triangle of Raleigh, Durham and Chapel Hill, North Carolina. Cary Academy is committed to providing a challenging academic program that integrates the best of traditional education with new and emerging technologies. Cary Academy's mission is to create a learning community dedicated to discovery, innovation, collaboration and excellence.

## **Special Programs**

World Language Exchange Program: Our World Language Department coordinates an exchange program for all Upper School students during students' sophomore year. The program is based upon reciprocal partnerships between Cary Academy and schools in Argentina, China, France and Germany. Students have the opportunity to spend 15-20 days abroad — living with a host family, visiting their school, and experiencing daily life in the host community. In return, Cary Academy students and their families receive students from partner schools for a similar program in our own community.

**Discovery Term:** Cary Academy students participate in two-week Discovery Terms at the end of the freshman and junior years. The term is an opportunity to investigate areas outside the regular curriculum, either in short-term courses or, for juniors, through a Work Experience program.

#### **School Discipline Reporting Policy**

When asked, the school reports suspensions and provides a written explanation; we expect students to do the same.

#### No Rank/No GPA Policy

Because our graduating classes are small, our programs highly rigorous, and our range of grades narrow, *it is our policy to neither rank our students nor compute G.P.A.* Instead, we provide a junior year grade distribution.

### **Calendar and Graduation Requirements**

Cary Academy operates on a trimester system in a traditional August to June calendar. Students must take a minimum of 5 full credits each year. Graduation requirements include a minimum of 4 credits in English; 3 credits in Mathematics (including a minimum of Algebra II); 3 credits in History; 3 credits in Science to include biology, chemistry and physics; and 3 credits in a world language. In addition to those credits, students must take 2 credits in Fine Arts (Art and Design in 9th, plus 1.5 additional credits); Health in 9<sup>th</sup> grade; Emotional Health and P.E. in 10<sup>th</sup> grade; and one trimester of P.E. in 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades. Students may qualify for course load reductions in special circumstances.

#### Advanced (ADV), Honors (H), Summer, and Online Courses

Advanced (ADV): Cary Academy offers ADVANCED (ADV) courses in lieu of Advanced Placement (AP) courses. These courses, our highest level, are taught with the rigor and expectations of AP courses but allow teachers to emphasize areas of study not prescribed in the AP syllabus. Most Cary Academy students enrolled in ADV courses take the corresponding AP exam offered by The College Board. Typically, ADV courses are open only to 11th and 12th grade students.

In 2019-2020, Cary Academy offers 27 ADV courses. The following ADV courses meet three extra periods per week with no additional credit awarded: Advanced Biology (ADV), Advanced Chemistry (ADV), and Advanced Physics-Mechanics (ADV). English is not offered at the ADV level in Trimester 3 for juniors or seniors.

Honors (H): Cary Academy also offers Honors level courses in Geometry, Algebra II and Precalculus.

**Summer Session:** Cary Academy offers a full credit summer US History course and a 1/3 credit Creative Writing course. Both fulfill graduation requirements. The courses appear on the student's transcript in the following academic year.

**Online:** Cary Academy allows students to take one online course per year. Online courses are included on the transcript only if the provider has been approved by Cary Academy.
